- · Students admitted by transfer from other institutions shall follow transitory regulations with suitable fitment formulae approved by the competent authority.

 - · Discontinued or detained candidates are eligible when for re-admission 35 and next offered.
 - · The re-admitted candidate will be governed by the rules & regulations under which the candidate was admitted.
 - · Students admitted by transfer from other institutions shall follow transitory regulations with suitable fitment formulae approved by the competent authority.
 - · A student who is seeking readmission shall apply in the prescribed format within one week after the commencement of the class work. However, the readmission of a student shall be approved by the competent authority.



Point of Discussion 1: Promotion of Students Based on Credits

Proposal

It was proposed that a student be promoted to V semester if he/she fulfills the academic requirements of 50% of the credits up to III semester or IV semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations besides securing prescribed minimum attendance in IV semester and a student shall be promoted to VII semester if he/she fulfills the academic requirements of 50% of the credits up to V semester or VI semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations besides securing prescribed minimum attendance in VI semester.

Discussion

The Academic Council studied the proposal in detail and meticulously reviewed its merits.

Resolution

It was resolved that a student be promoted to V semester if he/she fulfills the academic requirements of 50% of the credits up to IV semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations besides securing prescribed minimum attendance in IV semester. It was also resolved that a student shall be promoted to VII semester if he/she fulfills the academic requirements of 50% of the credits up to VI semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations besides securing prescribed minimum attendance in VI semester.

Point of Discussion 2: Syllabus for Mid-term Exam

Proposal

The following is the syllabus proposed for conducting Mid-term exams:

Mid-1: Unit-1(Part -A & Part-B), Unit-2 (Part- A & Part-B) and Unit-3 (Part-A)

Mid 2: Unit-3 (Part - B), Unit-4 (Part- A & Part-B) and Unit-5 (Part- A & Part-B).

Discussion

The Academic Council took this proposal up for discussion and suggested a few amendments to the syllabus for Mid-term exam.

Resolution

It was resolved that there shall not be any division like part A and part B. It was also resolved that the syllabus for the Mid-term exam shall be distributed in the following pattern:

MID-1: Units I, II and III (First 50%)

MID-2: Units III (Second 50%), IV and V

Point of Discussion 3: Question Paper Pattern for Semester-End Exam

Proposal

The proposed question paper pattern for the semester-end exam consists of two parts-Part-A and Part-B. Part-A of the question paper consists of 5 questions of two marks each and the student shall answer all the questions. Part-B of the question paper consists of 5 questions, each question with internal choice (one question from Part-A of the unit and the other from Part-B of the unit) from each of the five units, for 12 Marks. The student shall answer all 5 questions.

Discussion

The proposed question paper pattern for Semester-end Exam was perused and the Academic Council studied the proposal and recommended a few changes in the question paper pattern. As per the discussion, no change was proposed in terms of Part-A of the question paper.

Resolution

The Academic Council resolved that the Semester-end Exam shall be conducted for 3 hours duration at the end of the semester and the question paper shall be given in the following pattern:

a) Part A: It contains 5 questions of 2 marks each for all theory courses. The student shall answer all questions.

b) Part B: It contains 5 questions, each question with internal choice from each of the five units for 12 Marks. The student shall answer all 5 questions.

Point of Discussion 4: Internal Evaluation for Theory Courses

Proposal

It was proposed that each course be evaluated for 30 marks as part of internal evaluation.

- Two Unit Tests, each for 20 marks and of 40 minutes duration, shall be conducted and reduced to 10 marks. The final Unit Test marks shall be awarded giving a weightage of 70% of the Unit Test in which the student scores more marks and 30 % of the Unit Test in which the student scores less marks.
- 2. It was also proposed that two Mid-term (Mid 1 and Mid 2) Examinations, each for 15 marks and of 90 minute duration shall be conducted. The final Mid-term marks shall be awarded giving a weightage of 70% in the Mid-term Examination in which the student scores more marks and 30% for the Mid-term Examination in which the student scores less marks. The question paper shall contain three comprehensive questions with internal choice from each of the units, for 5 marks. The student is required to answer all the questions.
- 3. A weightage in internal marks up to a maximum of 5 marks shall be given, out of 30 marks, towards Assignments.

Discussion

The Academic Council studied and verified the proposed internal evaluation criteria for theory courses.

Resolution

The Academic Council appreciated the pattern that was proposed for internal evaluation for theory courses and ratified it.

Point of Discussion 5: Computation of Grades

Proposal

It was proposed that the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) be calculated as SGPA (S_i) = Σ (C_i x G_i) / Σ C_i where C_i is the number of credits of the ith course and G_i is the grade point scored by the student in the ith course and Cumulative Grade Point Average is calculated as CGPA = Σ (C_i x S_i) / Σ C_i where S_i is the SGPA of the ith semester and C_i is the total number of credits in that semester. The SGPA and CGPA is rounded off to 2 decimal points and reported in transcripts as Equivalent Percentage = (CGPA-0.5) x10.

Discussion

The Academic Council held a detailed discussion on the computation of grades and proposed to amend the clause regarding equivalent percentage.

Resolution

It was resolved to calculate the equivalent percentage in the following way: Equivalent Percentage = $(CGPA-0.75) \times 10$.

Point of Discussion 6: Evaluation of Labs

Proposal

It was proposed that all the labs be evaluated for 100 Marks: Internal 30M + External 70M.

Marks for internal lab exam are proposed to be distributed in the following manner:

Internal Test

15M

Record

5M

Day-to-day Performance

10M

Discussion

The Academic Council, having taken into consideration the importance of evaluation, made a few suggestions regarding the evaluation of labs.

Resolution

It was resolved that the labs be evaluated for 100M: Internal 40M + External 60M. It was also resolved that the internal labs be evaluated observing the following criteria:

Point of Discussion 1: External Question Paper Pattern for M. Tech, MCA and MBA

Proposal

It was proposed that the external question paper for M. Tech. and MCA shall consist of 8 questions out of which the student shall answer 5 questions (each question carries 12M). The external question paper for MBA shall consist of 8 questions out of which a student shall answer 5 questions (each question carries 10M) and one compulsory question (10M) on case study.

Discussion

The Academic Council verified the proposed external question paper pattern for M. Tech., MCA and MBA and proposed amendments in the pattern for enhancement of quality in terms of evaluation.

Resolution

It was resolved that the Semester-end Examination for M. Tech. and MCA shall be conducted for 60 marks where 5 questions, given from each of the five units, are to be answered with internal choice. It was also resolved that the external question paper for MBA shall consist of two parts: Part A and Part B. Part A is a compulsory case study question for 10 Marks and Part B consists of 5 questions with internal choice for 10 marks, from each of the five units.

Point of Discussion 2: Award of Grades for Project Works

Proposal

It was proposed that a candidate shall secure either Satisfactory Grade or Unsatisfactory Grade after the completion of the project viva-voce exam.

Discussion

The Academic Council reviewed the grades given to the candidates for the project works and suggested to include grades like Excellent and Good besides Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory.

Resolution

It was resolved that the project grades given to the candidates based on their performance shall be termed as Excellent/Good/Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory.

Point of Discussion 3: Computation of Grades

Proposal

It was proposed that the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) be calculated as SGPA (S_i) = Σ (C_i x G_i) / Σ C_i where C_i is the number of credits of the ith course and G_i is the grade point scored by the student in the ith course and Cumulative Grade Point Average is calculated as CGPA = Σ (C_i x S_i) / Σ C_i where S_i is the SGPA of the ith semester and C_i is the total number of credits in that semester. Also the Council suggested that this may be discussed and finalized in the next Academic Council meeting and that the amendment may be included in the next regulation, if approved.

Resolution

It was resolved that the suggestion given be presented in the next Academic Council meeting and due approval may be taken.

Point of Discussion 3: Academic Audits

Proposal

No specific proposal was made by the college regarding the Academic Audits as ISO Academic Audits take place regularly. But, the point was raised for discussion to seek clarity on the issue.

Discussion

The Council apprised the members to conduct Academic Audits by inviting external experts and added that the audits should focus on quality of internal question papers, consistency in COs and POs, evaluation process and consistency in internal evaluation and external evaluation.

Resolution

It was resolved that the Academic Audits be conducted on a regular basis.
