In Part-A, Question I shall contain 5 compulsory short answer questions for a total of 10 marks such that each question carries 2 marks.  There shall be 1 short answer questions from each unit.  In Part-B, There shall be 5 either/or type questions (totally 10 questions from 1 to 10) of 12 marks each. Students shall answer any one of them..  The Part-B questions shall be set by covering one unit of the syllabus for each question.</p>	<p>One Question from each unit with internal choice. Total = 5X14 = 70 Marks</p> <p><b>Reform – In the assessment equal weightage is there to all Cos with internal choice in each unit</b></p>
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
